

CSIRO Astronomy and Space Science invites the astronomical community to a Town Hall-style discussion on the Australia Telescope National Facility (ATNF). Topics will include ASKAP early science and future Parkes instrumentation. This session will be one of a series of forums over the coming months in which the community is invited to interact with CASS on the strategy for the ATNF telescopes.

The ATNF currently consists of the Parkes Telescope, Australia Telescope Compact Array, and access to the Mopra Telescope and NASA's Canberra Deep Space Communication Complex (Tidbinbilla) Telescopes. The Australian SKA Pathfinder (ASKAP) will also be part of the ATNF.
